Title: Investigating the experience of discrimination/ discriminating practices on one group in contemporary Irish Society and the impact on that group of the discrimination (LO4 Social Studies & LO10 Social Studies)

Guidelines:

The learner will complete a project that will enable him/her to demonstrate the ability to understand and apply concepts associated with social studies (LO1 Social Studies). To do this the learner will:

- Work independently to exercise initiative in following a plan on how to complete this project (LO10 Social Studies & LO11 Social Studies)
- Select one group from the following list as the focus for this project (LO4 Social Studies & LO10 Social Studies):
 - Members of the Gay and/or transgender community
 - Members of the Traveller community
 - Immigrant and migrant workers of diverse racially and cultural backgrounds
 - o Minority religions
 - Elderly people
- Investigate the discrimination/discriminating practices encountered by the chosen group in Irish Society (LO10 Social Studies):
 - Research the topic using both primary and secondary research and qualitative and quantitative methods, as appropriate (LO6 Social Studies)
 - Include evidence of research from a variety of sources, for example, correspondence, note taking, interviews, tape recordings etc.
 (LO11 Social Studies & LO8 Communications)

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- In investigating, ensure to demonstrate your ability to:
 - o Discuss key issues
 - Establish validity and reliability (LO8 Communications)
 - Explore theoretical concepts
 - Give insight into the lives of people in contemporary society
 - Objectively examine the evidence, making reference to sources
 - \circ $\;$ Draw logical inferences from the research you have undertaken
- Decide on appropriate survey methods and other enquiry techniques and methods, and apply these as investigative strategies in your research. Design the tools necessary to apply these strategies, for example, a questionnaire, a set of interview questions, a template to record observations etc. (LO7 Social Studies & LO8 Communications)
- Use a minimum of two types of media to access information, for example, information technology, library classification system (LO8 Social Studies)
- Use the Harvard system of referencing to document and acknowledge all relevant sources consulted (LO9 Social Studies & LO8 Communications)
- Produce a well constructed bibliography (LO9 Social Studies)
- Analyse and evaluate the findings of your research to draw conclusions about the discrimination/discriminating practices encountered by the chosen group (LO12 Social Studies)
- Discuss possible strategies to alleviate the discriminating practices for this group (LO12 Social Studies)

Include in the finished project:

- a coherent plan outlining the approach you will take to completing the project
- a summary of the following:
 - the difference between both primary and secondary research (LO6 Social Studies)
 - the differences between qualitative and quantitative methods (LO6 Social Studies)
- a reflection and evaluation of the learning process
- relevant visual supports to lend credence to your findings, for example, drawings, charts, photographs or other appropriate supports (LO3 Communications)
- a summary of the relevant health, safety and welfare legislation that was observed when completing this report, for example, the Data Protection Act, the Freedom of Information Act, copyright or other appropriate legislation (LO2 Communications)

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- the inclusion of a cover sheet with your name and the titles and codes of both components
- the inclusion of a contents page
- all pages are numbered
- each section has a heading and the project is compiled in a systematic manner
- the report is word-processed, presented with 1.5 line spacing and 12pt Arial font
- the report is well structured, detailed and balanced
- spelling, punctuation and syntax are correct (LO9 Communications)

In completing this project/report the learner should:

- use the language associated with social studies fluently and confidently
- use impersonal language
- demonstrate an in-depth understanding of the subject matter
- explore the theoretical concepts associated with social studies
- demonstrate a high level of initiative, evaluation skills, analytical and reflective thinking
- express ideas clearly, systematically and comprehensively
- present coherent, detailed and focused evidence

Assessment Criteria:

- Findings presented clearly.
- Report compiled systematically.

Analysis (25 marks)

- Evidence examined objectively making references to sources.
- Inferences are drawn logically from foregoing material.

- Reflection and evaluation of the learning process.
